

Terms and Conditions for the Dresden International Scholarship

1. Purpose of the terms of participation

Die Dresden School of Management chooses scholarship holders among the participants of the "Dresden Internationals Scholarship". Prospective international students of all study programmes that are offered at Dresden School of Management in the winter semester 2020 may apply.

Several partial scholarships (up to 50%) will be awarded for the winter semester 2020 intake. The scholarships are granted for the first year of study.

2. Participation and admission requirements

The following participation requirements will be considered for the selection of candidates:

- Complete application documents for a study programme at Dresden School of Management including the current performance overview (university entrance qualification certificate or, for Master's/MBA programmes, university transcript or, if not yet available, a current grade overview). Applicants decide whether to submit either an essay (Option 1) or a video (Option 2) for the scholarship.
- **Option 1:** Submission of an essay – max. size: 1 DIN A4 page - on the topic "Why do I deserve the Dresden International Scholarship?". Please upload the essay with your other application documents during your online application or – if the study application for the winter semester 2020 was already submitted - upload the essay to the following website.
- **Option 2:** Submission of a video – max. length: 1 minute - on the topic "Why do I deserve the Dresden International Scholarship?" within the deadline. Please upload the video with your other application documents during your online application or – if the study application for the winter semester 2020 was already submitted - upload the video to the following website.

Any submitted documents and/or works will not be returned. The partial scholarships will be awarded on a rolling basis starting with the publication of the scholarship competition. The partial scholarship cannot be combined with other offers, such as discount on enrolment fee, discount on deposit, fast lane offer, etc.

Eligible participants are international students aged 18 or over who already fulfil or will fulfil the admission requirements for the respective study programme. Participants under the age of 18 require written consent of their legal representatives.

Members of Dresden School of Management (current students, lecturers, employees etc.) are excluded from participation.

The admission requirements for the relevant study programmes are available on the website of the Dresden School of Management.

In order to join a study programme at Dresden School of Management, applicants must acknowledge further legal and contractual obligations for the admission to study at Dresden School of Management.

If the respective programme does not start in the winter semester 2020, the scholarship starts with the first subsequent intake of the programme. By participating in the scholarship competition, the terms and conditions of the competition are accepted.

3. Decision about the awarding of partial performance scholarships

Partial scholarships will only be awarded to international applicants who return their signed study contract to Dresden School of Management within two weeks of receipt of the contract (guarantee) and transfer the enrolment fee and the stipulated deposit within the above-mentioned two weeks.

The Dresden School of Management takes school/academic performance, motivation to study, volunteering, creativity and quality of the contribution into consideration when evaluating the contribution to the scholarship competition.

4. Scope of the partial performance scholarship

Scholarship holders will receive a partial scholarship that reduces the monthly or semester tuition fees of the first study year by up to 50%.

The partial scholarship is awarded for one academic year.

“Tuition fees” refer to the regular fees that must be paid per month or per semester for the studies at Dresden School of Management, as stipulated in the contract. Additional costs such as enrolment fee, semester ticket fee and further expenses related to the studies are not included and must be paid separately.

Payment of the scholarship in cash is not permitted. The scholarship is not transferable. The disbursement of scholarships is expressly prohibited in the following cases: no-show, study interruption, leave of absence or similar.

5. Copyright

Participants of the scholarship contest guarantee with their agreement to the conditions of participation that:

- They have created the essay or video independently and are the sole copyright owners of all documents and works submitted to the scholarship contest
- They are free to dispose of the work as well as of the rights of use and the transferable copyrights
- The work is free of third-party rights
- Individuals that appear in photos, videos or other media submitted to the contest agree with their depiction and the publication of their image
- In case particular objects or texts appear in photos, videos or other media submitted to the contest, no third-party rights exist, or third parties expressly agree to the depiction and publication of images
- In this context, they release Dresden School of Management as a precautionary measure from all claims of third parties, including reasonable costs of legal defence.

Participants agree that documents, works and data submitted to the scholarship contest will be stored on a server. Furthermore, they agree to the publication of the essay or video, in part or in

their entirety, on all official social media channels (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, LinkedIn, Youtube, Vimeo) and on the websites of Dresden School of Management. The university reserves the right to edit the essay or video for publication on the websites and on social media to ensure a proper presentation of the content, without defamiliarizing the contributions.

Participants transfer the non-exclusive right to use the documents including the right to mention the name to Dresden School of Management.

The transfer of rights of use is unlimited in time, space and content. Every participant permits to the publication of submitted documents/works or parts of them on the social media channels and on the websites of Dresden School of Management.

6. Use of personal data

Data provided with the application will only be collected and used to inform participants about the status of the scholarship contest.

With their participation in the scholarship contest, applicants consent to the publication of their name, the submitted contribution and the photos of the scholarship award ceremony on the social media channels and on the websites of Dresden School of Management.

7. Data protection

The Dresden School of Management will regard all applicable data protection regulations in their currently valid versions. Image and video data as well as the personal data provided will be stored, processed and used by Dresden School of Management within the framework of the implementation of the scholarship contest.

Participants have the right to object at any time to the collection, processing and use of documents and media submitted to the scholarship contest, to revoke their consent and to request information about the stored data at any time. The conditions of participation remain unaffected.

8. Violation of the terms of participation

Any violation of the terms of participation leads to a withdrawal of the scholarship. In particular, this applies if the participant makes false statements, is not eligible to participate or submitted scholarship contributions violate applicable law or the rights of third parties.

9. Miscellaneous

Should individual provisions of these terms of participation be or become invalid, inadmissible or unenforceable, this shall not affect the validity of the remaining terms of participation.

Regarding the right to participate in the contest, an eventual exclusion and the decision of the selection committee are final and not subject to legal recourse. Only the law of the Federal Republic of Germany is applicable. Place of jurisdiction is Berlin.
